I. TYPES OF SUBMISSIONS

1 Individual presentations

1.1. Keynote Addresses

The organizers will propose a list of invited keynote speakers, on their own. We are however encouraging others, especially regional IACCP representatives, to suggest the names of other candidates who are well-know specialists in any domain of cross-cultural psychology and related disciplines, in their respective regions. By keynote address we consider a one hour lecture, presenting an expertly, state-of-art contribution.

1.2. Oral Papers (Thematic sessions)

The Scientific Committee will group individual oral presentations in thematic sessions of 90 minutes duration, featuring up to five speakers. Oral presentations should not exceed 15 minutes each, with five minutes allowed for discussion after each presentation. Audio/visual equipment is available on request.

1.3. Conversation Hour

Conversation hour may be the right choice of presentation for those of you who wish to discuss some research ideas or practical applications in a less structured way than it is done during formal paper presentation. This format is advisable if you want to discuss some collaborative effort, particularly with students.

1.4. Posters

Although we encourage posters symposia as a new kind of congress activity, there will be time and space allotted to individual poster sessions grouped thematically by the Scientific Committee. Posters should be prepared in a “universal” display format, fitted to 90cm (height) x 140cm (width) [40inch x 55inch] boards.

1.5. Workshops

A workshop proposal should be either a presentation of a research strategy (measurement instrument, statistical program etc.) or an intervention program. In each case specific skill that the participants are supposed to acquire should be outlined. Workshops should not be profit-oriented.

Workshops will be held on Sunday, July 16 from the morning hours on, before the official Congress opening. Their duration may vary from 4 to 8

hours.

2. Group presentations

2.1. Round table (panel) discussions

This kind of session should be organized with the aim of discussing some of the “hot”, controversial topics in the field of cross-cultural psychology and in related disciplines. It is advisable to have panelists who represent different points of view and are acknowledged specialists in their field / domain. There should be at least four members of the panel and the moderator / convener, representing not less than three different countries.

2.2. Paper Symposia

Time allocated for the paper symposia would be one and a half an hour or three hours. For the former there should be four or five speakers including the discussant. The longer, three-hour symposium may bring together six or seven presenters and a discussant. In line with IACCP regulations the panelists of the symposium should represent three or more countries (including the discussant).

2.3. Workshops

See paragraph 1.5 for more information.

2.4. Poster Symposia

This new program category offers a possibility for presenting related poster contributions and is aimed at young doctoral and pre-doctoral researchers. Submissions in this category must identify a coordinator, at least five poster presentations, and at least one chair. The chair should open the session with his/her remarks and then give each presenter a floor for five minutes summarize of their posters. During the remaining time the chair will field questions and facilitate discussions between the audience and the authors. We appeal to students (under- and graduate levels) and their supervisors to consider this type of congress presentation.

II. SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

All submissions of Congress presentation proposals should be sent to the Scientific Committee by the First Author (for the individual presentations) or by the Convener (for group presentations). For group presentations, the Convener must gather together all material and send it in a single mailing. Please write all information (e.g. institution names, city and country

names) in legible English.

Required submission documents are:

1. Cover sheet and Abstract for all types of individual presentations;
2. Group Cover Sheet, Group Abstract, and Individual Presenters' Abstracts, for symposia presentations;
3. Group Cover Sheet, and Group Abstract, for panel discussions and poster symposia.

Authors may send submission information by e-mail or by postal mail.

We strongly urge all participants to **send their proposals by e-mail** when possible. This will facilitate handling and decrease errors. Instructions for submitting proposals by e-mail and postal mail are listed below.

2. E-mail submission

Submission forms reproducing those attached below in this Circular may be found at the site www.psychpan.waw.pl/iaccpxv.htm. They may be completed and sent to IACCPXV@psychpan.waw.pl with subject SUBMISSION in the head of the message.

Group Abstract Forms should be completed and sent out by the session conveners. Individual Abstract Forms should be completed and sent out by the first or individual authors.

If you are planning to submit both individual and group presentations, you will need to send a separate e-mail for each type of form.

3. Postal mail submission

You will need to mail a completed Cover Sheet and Abstract(s) Forms.

Since Abstracts will also be reproduced electronically on computer diskettes for distribution at the Congress, we strongly encourage to submit your abstracts on diskette as well as on paper. Diskettes should be 3^{1/2}" Double Sided, High Density, in IBM DOS Format. Text should be saved as an ASCII Text file. Be sure to label the diskette with your name and submission type (individual or group).

Cover Sheets

Attached are Submission Cover Sheets (one for individual presentations, and one for group presentation). You may use the photocopies of these forms if necessary. Please type the cover sheets or write the information in

black ink block letters.

Abstracts

Attached are Individual and Group Abstracts forms. You may use the abstract form provided or type the information on a separate sheet of paper following the guidelines below

You must use at least a 2.5 cm margin and a 12-point type, with *no italics* and **no bold**.

4. Deadlines and conditions

Deadline for submission proposals of keynote addresses, panel discussions, workshops and paper symposia is **January 1st, 1999**; while the acceptance / rejection decision of the scientific committee will be communicated to you not later than February 20th, 2000.

Deadline for all other submissions, including individual papers, conversation hours and all kinds of poster sessions is **January 31st, 2000**; while the acceptance / rejection decision of the scientific committee will be communicated to you not later than February 29th, 2000.

The evaluation, acceptance or rejection of all proposals is at the discretion of the Scientific Committee.

The Scientific Committee will not take into consideration proposals without abstracts. The final and definitive acceptance will be confirmed after payment of the enrolment fee for the Congress.

The official language of the Congress is English.

The Congress will provide, on request, free overhead projectors, slide projectors, and flipcharts. Other equipment can be rented, at participant's expense.
